## DESCRIPTION

Explore Albany on a leisurely ride around town and Mt Clarence to Middleton Beach.

It is a short ride into the Albany Heritage Park and National Anzac Centre. The sweeping views from the Desert Mounted Corps Memorial and Padre White Lookout are spectacular and well worth the steep climb.

The local produce markets, Museum, Arts Centre and other historic buildings and places of interest are all in the Town Centre and easy to get to by bike.

There are plenty of cafes and restaurants along the way.

## **ROUTE DIRECTIONS**

**Start:** Albany Entertainment Centre, Princess Royal Drive.

- 1. Cross the footbridge and go right into Stirling Terrace, which becomes Brunswick Road.
- 2. Towards the top of the hill follow the road left into Cuddihy Street and right into Marine Drive.
- 3. Go left at the entrance to the Albany Heritage Park and on to the roundabout. Forts Road leads to the National Anzac Centre and the Garrison Restaurant. Apex Drive leads to the Desert Mounted Corps Memorial and Padre White Lookout. It's a steep climb towards the end.
- 4. Return to Marine Drive which winds around to Middleton Beach, with spectacular viewing points along the way. Middleton Beach is at the bottom of the hill.
- 5. To return to the Town Centre, go left at the roundabout and follow Adelaide Crescent around Eyre Park.
- 6. Turn left at the roundabout and follow Middleton Road back to town.
- 7. Just after 'Dog Rock" on the right, cross the roundabout and go down Aberdeen St.
- 8. Go right at the T Junction into Peels Place, then left down York Street.
- 9. Turn left at the roundabout into Stirling Terrace and return back to the start.
